Important - Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly





SAFETY AND CARE ADVICE

- Check you have all the components and tools listed.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- We do not recommend the use of power drills/drivers for inserting screws, as this could damage the unit. Only use hand screwdrivers and Allen keys.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could cause choking if swallowed.
- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Do not overtighten the nuts to avoid causing damage to the threads.

- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do no use bleach or abrasive cleaners.
- From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit
- This product should not be discarded with household waste. Take to your local authority waste disposal centre

1. Touch the up/down button to adjust the height of the desk; the desktop runs to the lowest point and displays bot; the desktop runs to the highest point, displays top.

2. key button: 1,2,3,4 are the four height memory keys.

When the desk is in a static state, long press the button "1" for three seconds, the display shows "5-?", which means the save is successful.
 Buttons "2", "3", and "4" all have the same height memory function as button "1", repeat the above steps to save the height to the corresponding position 2 or 3 or 4, and the display screen will corresponding show "5-? or "5-? " or "5-? ".

(3). When the tabletop is at any height, press the "1" or "2" or "3" or "4" button to automatically adjust to the previously saved location.

Press the 3 and the 4 buttons simultaneously, long press for 5 seconds, the screen will show RST direction, keep pressing to achieve the reset.
 The desk has two USB ports and one type-C port, they can supply power to other electronics and support charging protocol.

Type-C Output: 5V3A/9V2A/12V1.5A; Type-A Output: 3.6-6.5V2.4A/6.5-9V2A/12V1.5A; Total output power of single port: 18W Max. When the desk is lifting, the output will be stopped; when lifting stops, the output will be restarted.

5. Short press the "LOCK" button to achieve the child lock function, so as to avoid accidentally touch and guarantee the safety of children;

The key lock and unlock is switchable, screen will show "Loc" when the desk is locked.

6. Sensitivity switch, long press the up and down button simultaneously, the anti-collision function will be closed when the screen shows "A-0"; the sensitivity is at 1 level when the screen shows "A-1", the sensitivity is at 2 level when the screen shows "A-2", the sensitivity is at 3 level when the screen shows "A-3", the 3 level is the most sensitive.

Troubleshooting:

a. Reset: When the LED shows"#5f", press "V" button until the desk reaches its lowest height and rebounds to stop, it means the reset has been finished.

b. When it doesn't work and the LED shows "E01" or "E02", please retry 18 minutes later.

c. If the "▼" button doesn't work, please check the cable connection and then cut off the power for at least 10 seconds. Reconnect to the power and press "▼" button to start the reset process when it shows the "#5/".

d. If all these above process are inefficient, please contact our customer service.



Common fault treatment

The following tips will help you detected and eliminate the common fault and error. If the fault you met is not listed below, please contact with your supplier. Only the manufacturer and professionals are capable for investigating and correcting those fault and error.
